GENERAL COMMENTS: A Premarital Agreement is simply a contract between two partners contemplating marriage which settles property distribution and monetary payment issues, such as alimony or spousal support, in case of marriage dissolution such as divorce or annulment. A Premarital Agreement can also cover a wide variety of other matters, including living arrangements during marriage and other issues between the couple. Most gentlemen clients however wish to keep the provisions of the Premarital Agreement simple, and focus on the maximum protection of their pre-marriage assets in the event of divorce.

The purpose of this Questionnaire is to gather some basic information to begin the process of preparing your Premarital Agreement.

QUESTIONS

NEED FOR A PREMARITAL AGREEMENT, AND YOUR INTENTIONS AND GOALS

1. Why do you feel you need a Premarital Agreement? What are your intentions and goals with regards to your Premarital Agreement?

FULL DISCLOSURE

2. Are you prepared to make a full disclosure of all your assets and property to your prospective spouse?

FULL UNDERSTANDING AND VOLUNTARINESS

3. Would you agree to pay for an appointment with a Foreign-speaking attorney to represent your prospective spouse separately to explain the agreement to her, if a “Waiver of Counsel” provision is NOT allowed in your home state?

LACK OF DURESS

4. How long before the date of marriage do you plan on signing the agreement with your prospective spouse?

LAW OF COUPLE'S STATE OF RESIDENCE APPLICABLE

5. Where do you intend to marry? What state do you intend to reside in with your spouse?

FAIR AND REASONABLE PROVISIONS

6. Most U.S. Gentlemen who wish to do a Premarital Agreement seek to protect some of their property. A. What property specifically are you trying to protect from her in the event of divorce? B. **What amount of property distribution settlement or payout are you willing to pay her in exchange for protection of your other property?**

CHILD SUPPORT CANNOT BE AFFECTED BY AGREEMENT

7. Does your prospective spouse have any children of a previous marriage or relationship? How many? Do they carry the mother's last name? Will they reside with you?

TESTAMENTARY PROVISIONS

8. Do you wish the Premarital Agreement to address property distribution in the event of your death or the death of your spouse?

PROTECTION FOR YOUR CHILDREN OF PRIOR MARRIAGE OR RELATIONSHIP

9. Were you married before? How many times? Do you have any children of your own from a previous marriage or relationship, and if so, identify? If so, is one purpose of your Premarital Agreement to protect any share for your children?

REQUEST FOR ASSET LIST OF U.S. GENTLEMAN

PLEASE SUPPLY US WITH THE FULL LEGAL NAME, CURRENT ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, E-MAIL ADDRESS, DATE OF BIRTH, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR COUNTRY IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF YOURSELF AND YOUR FUTURE SPOUSE.

PLEASE SUPPLY US WITH A SIMPLE LIST OF YOUR ASSETS, BROKEN DOWN INTO CATEGORIES OF YOUR CHOICE, SUCH AS STOCKS & BONDS, REAL ESTATE, ETC., TOGETHER WITH YOUR BEST ESTIMATED "FAIR MARKET VALUE" OF EACH ASSET.
